What is eVA?

eVA is an electronic marketplace for buyers and sellers. eVA is an interactive web site for vendors to display goods and services to the Commonwealth state and local government.

General Requirements for use of eVA – Effective July 1, 2004

Effective July 1, 2004, all vendors interested in doing business with George Mason University are required to register with eVA, the Commonwealth of Virginia's electronic procurement system, <http://www.eva.state.va.us/>. All vendors are required to register in eVA before the university can award a contract and/or process vendor invoices.

Registration on the eVA website is Step One in doing business with George Mason University and 170 other local governments and state agencies in the Commonwealth of Virginia. To register, go to <http://evaregishelp.dgs.state.va.us/>
